With reference to your application dated 01/06/2023 and subsequent correspondence with the school in this regard, DAV COLLEGE TRUST AND MANAGEMENT SOCIETY operated DAV PUBLIC SCHOOL, S NO 157, PLOT NO 31, DP ROAD AUNDH PUNE 411007. UDISE No. 27251400108 (Permanent Unaided English Medium CBSE) provisionally recognizing the school for classes 1 to 8 for a period of three years from 1 April 2022 to 31 March 2025.

The above said approval is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions

1. The period of recognition shall not be extended and there shall be no obligation under any circumstances to grant recognition or supplement after Class VIII.
2. The school shall comply with the provisions of the Children's Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Schedule One) and the Maharashtra Right to Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 (Schedule Two).
3. The school shall admit children belonging to the nearest weaker sections and deprived groups, in the first grade, to the extent of at least 25% of the number of students in that grade and shall provide free and compulsory education to them till the completion of primary education, provided further that this standard shall be complied with in the case of pre-primary grade also.
4. For a child specified in paragraph 3, the school shall be provided with a separate bank account to receive reimbursement in accordance with section 12(2) of the Act.
5. The Institution / School shall not be liable for any capitation or levy and shall not be liable to the child or his/her parents or guardian for any examination.
6. Lack of proof of age for any child; Admission to the school shall not be denied on grounds of religion, caste or caste, place of birth or any of these.

7. (i) No child admitted to a school shall be retained in the same grade as he is or expelled from the school until the completion of primary education,
- (ii) No child shall be subjected to corporal punishment or mental torture.
- (iii) No child shall be required to pass any board examination till he completes primary education
- (iv) Every child who has completed primary education shall be given the certificate prescribed under rule 33,
- (v) Students with disabilities / special needs shall be included in accordance with the provisions of the Act
- (vi) Teachers possessing the minimum qualification prescribed under section 23 (1) of the Act shall be appointed. But further, the teachers who do not hold the minimum qualification on the date of commencement of the Act Minimum qualification has to be acquired within a period of 5 years. autonomy certification silent 2
- (vii) The teacher shall perform his/her duties specified in section 24 (1) of the Act, &
- (viii) The school shall ensure that the teacher/mistress does not engage herself in private tutoring.

8. The school shall follow the syllabus prepared on the basis of the syllabus prescribed by the appropriate authority.

9. The school shall admit students against the facilities available in the school as prescribed in section 19 of the Act.

10. The school shall adhere to the standards and norms specified in section 19 of the Act. The facilities available in the school at the time of last inspection were as follows :-

13. Under the School Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860) amended by the Bombay Public Trustees Act, 1950 It is being run through a registered institution.

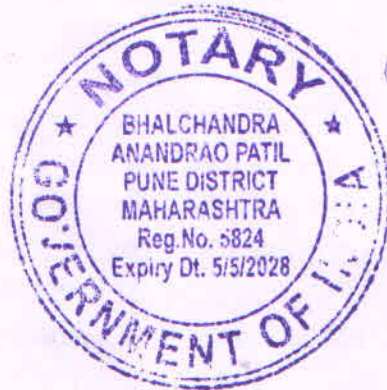
14. School for the benefit of any person, body or association of persons or any other person or any not operated for profit.
